<b>Description</b>	<p>The Marshall SWCD will administrate the 2019 Buffer Law. The Marshall SWCD will carry out:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Landowner outreach and information</li> <li>- Provide technical assistance to landowners</li> <li>- Potentially provide financial assistance to landowners</li> <li>- Purchase of equipment to support implementation</li> <li>- Provide alternative practice validations, if requested, where the prescribed buffer may not be the right water quality practice for a site</li> <li>- Review DNR maps and conduct landowner outreach prior to map finalization</li> <li>- Potentially adopt buffer recommendations for waters not mapped by DNR for inclusion in local water management plans</li> <li>- Implement the new statewide excessive soil erosion provisions that protect downstream waters and property owners from negligent or absent soil and water conservation management practices</li> <li>- Inventory of baseline conditions i.e. where buffers already exist</li> </ul>
