

RESOLUTION # 1
ADOPTING THE
MARSHALL COUNTY
COMPREHENSIVE LOCAL WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN
AS THE
COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF THE SWCD

Supervisor Berg offered the following resolution, No. 1, and moved its adoption.

WHEREAS, the Marshall Soil and Water Conservation District has been an active participant in the development and all updates of the Marshall County Comprehensive Local Water Management Plan (County Plan); and

WHEREAS, the County Plan has been approved by the Board of Water and Soil Resources and has been determined to be in compliance with all laws and rules governing water in the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, the County Plan includes a map and description of the soil classifications within the district; and

WHEREAS, the County Plan identifies the areas within the district where erosion, sedimentation, and related water quality problems are the most severe; and

WHEREAS, the County Plan identifies high priority erosion, sedimentation, and water quality problems in accordance with BWSR rules and guidelines.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

THAT THE Marshall Soil and Water Conservation District adopts the Marshall County Comprehensive Local Water Management Plan as its Comprehensive Plan for the time period of December 31, 2017 to December 31, 2022.
